Antonín Dvořák, the most famous Czech composer, wrote his Suite in New York, partly with typical Afroamerican spiritual idioms. V. J. Tomášek reminds here typical rhythms of F. Liszt - but during appearance this piece, Liszt was just 7 years old! J. N. Nardelli is a sister of Mrs. Šárka Nečasová - and prematurely died J. Ježek, a huge individuality as in classical as in popular music, is presented here by three pieces for theatre.
